


Purpose of the study





Setbacks OUR LEARNING CURVE

Initial Data DESCRIPTIVE



121 Responses



- Most frequent language: French (61,8%)
- English language skills: 45% state conversational level or fluent
- Greek language skills: 4 participants state conversational level or fluent

40,8% have completed at least 12 years of Education

Living Conditions

72,6% have experienced inadequate shelter and/or homelessness while in Greece

17,7% are currently homeless

56,1% state that they don't feel safe in their current living conditions

Racism - Discrimination - Harassment

63,4% felt afraid of the police

VS

41,5% verbal abuse by native Greeks

VS

79,7% felt afraid of other REF-AS

77,2% verbal abuse by other REF-AS

Mental Health

95,1% state they feel depressed and have trouble sleeping

87% feel anxiety on a regular basis

41,5% feel hopeless about their future

68,3% see themselves as courageous survivors

Sexual Health and risk behaviours

41% have stated the have engaged in sexual actions in exchange for food, housing and/or money

63,9% haven't received info on sexual health

55% had never been tested for HIV

48,7% haven't used condom the last 5 times they had sex

COVID-19

78% has not received information about COVID-19 and its ways of transmission

64,8% has never been tested for COVID-19
